Early Years

Our children in Reception follow the Early Year Curriculum and learn through play both inside and in the outside classroom. We ensure that our children feel secure and that they develop self-confidence and resilience through their daily learning. We consolidate their skills through Planning in the Moment where their individual interests and needs are nurtured and developed. We also teach discreet Phonic and Maths lessons daily.

The Foundation stage has seven key areas of learning as follows:

The majority of our learning in Reception is child initiated and our committed and professional staff use 2 simple assessment to observe children's learning and decide on individual Next Steps.

Partnership with parents

We have regular meetings to discuss each child's needs and skills We offer regular Stay Play and Learn sessions for parents to come and work alongside their child and to understand ways in which they can support their child's learning at home.
