**As Writers we will be studying Shakespeare plays :
"Macbeth" and "Romeo and Juliet"**

We will:

- focus on Shakespearian language
- Write an emotive letter from a perspective of one of the characters
- Write a newspaper article about one of these stories

As Mathematicians we will be learning about:

- mental addition and subtraction
- fractions
- formal methods for multiplication
- properties of 2D shapes
- angles
- measures

As Computer Technologists we will be developing and interactive game using Scratch and continuing our Online Safety.

As Geographers we will be:

- Looking at how different countries work together to invent new materials

As Historians we will be learning:

- the Saxons and Vikings

As God's Children we will be:

- Looking into particular and significant memory
- Making links between memories and behaviour
- Studying the Eucharist (a memorial sacrifice in the Jewish sense of remembering that makes present a past reality. In the New Testament, the memorial takes on a new meaning (The Eucharist commemorates Christ's Passover.
- Studying the Scripture: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

As Artists we will be:

As Scientists we will be studying :

•Making New Materials

(comparing and grouping together everyday materials on the basis of their properties; using knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated)
