- explain about the water cycle



- √ 'Fix it Time'






Time: 8am Please wear PE kit with swimming costume/trunks underneath.

White swim hat with school logo

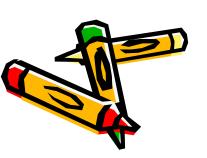
Goggles are optional

You may drive into Coopers' car park before this time.


We will wait next to the fence on the far side, so that the children can be dropped off from the car without having to cross the car park. This is a very busy car park so please be careful which side they get out of the car!




If it is raining before 8am, we will meet in front of the entrance to the school building where there is a bit of shelter.






When the lesson has finished and the children are changed, we all walk back to school so please check the weather to ensure the children have appropriate coats etc. We walk in all weathers!





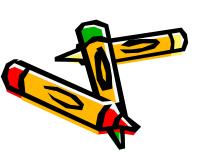
